

ORDINANCE 234

BOROUGH OF RICHLAND

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING AND REGULATING OUT OF DOOR FIRES.

Section 1: RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING THE AREA OF FIRES UPON PUBLIC PROPERTY:

Except as provided below, no person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys, or public property in the Borough of Richland, or burn or cause to be burned thereon papers, boxes, rubbish, leaves, garbage, or other materials or substances of any kind.

Section 2: RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING THE AREA OF FIRES UPON PRIVATE PROPERTY:

Except as provided below, no person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon private property in the Borough of Richland, or burn or cause to be burned thereon papers, boxes, rubbish, leaves, garbage or other materials or substances of any kind.

Section 3: EXCEPTIONS

The following exceptions to Section 1 and Section 2 are hereby allowed:

(1) Out of door fires commonly known as charcoal fires or similar fires where the express purpose for and utilization of such fire is the cooking and preparation of food, are permitted.

(2) Upon formal written application made to the Council of the Borough of Richland, the owner or lessee of real property situate in the Borough may burn or cause to be burned such materials or substances which result from the clearance of land for agricultural or property beautification purposes. if

the same cannot be disposed of in any other manner except through large economic cost. Said burning must be properly supervised and must be accomplished upon the property of the owner or lessee.

Section 4: PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF:

Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and/or be imprisoned for not more than ten (10) days.
