

ORDINANCE NO. 301

RICHLAND BOROUGH, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RICHLAND, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA WHICH REPEALS A PORTION OF THE BURNING ORDINANCE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH SECTION 4.55(2) AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE BAN OF OUT OF DOOR FIRES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Richland, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. Section 4.54(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Richland, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania is hereby repealed and is deleted from the Codified Ordinances, which section reads as follows:

"4.54(2) Upon formal written application made to the Council of the Borough of Richland, the owner or lessee of real property situated in the Borough may burn or cause to be burned such materials or substances which result from the clearance of land for agricultural or property beautification purposes, if the same cannot be disposed of in any other manner except through large economic cost. Said burning must be properly supervised and must be accomplished upon the property of the owner or lessee."

Section 2. All other provisions of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough dealing with out of door fires shall remain in force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinances shall become effective upon twenty (20) days after its passage.
