

ORDINANCE NO. 326

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RICHLAND, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO PROHIBIT DUMPING OF DEBRIS AND REFUSE AND RELATED MATERIALS ON BOROUGH PROPERTY AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained by the Council of the Borough of Richland, as follows:

SECTION I Section 4.21 of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Richland, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, shall be amended to delete the section and replace it by the following language:

"It shall be unlawful for anyone to throw or dump waste paper, sweeping, ashes, house waste, water, water waste, nails or waste, debris or rubbish of any kind into or onto any road, street, highway, alley, municipal right-of-way, municipal parking lot or sidewalk; or interfere with, scatter or disturb the contents of any receptacle containing ashes, garbage, household waste or rubbish, which shall be placed upon any sidewalk or elsewhere for the collection of contents, thereof."

SECTION II Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance concerning disorderly conduct and upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before any District Magistrate, shall be sentenced to pay a fine for each such offense of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and costs, shall be committed to the Lebanon County Prison for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION III In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of this Borough that such remainder shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.

SECTION V This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
