

Richland Borough Council – Special Meeting
Monday, November 4, 2024, 7:00 p.m.

A special meeting of the Richland Borough Council was held on Monday, November 4, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the meeting room at the Richland Borough Building. The President being in the chair and the Secretary being present.

President Bricker called the Richland Borough Council Special Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and asked everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Bricker completed roll call, Present were President Kelly Bricker, President Pro Tem Larry Hartman, Councilmembers, Robert Rittle, James Niethammer, Richard Strickler, Matthew Johnson, and Secretary Rebecca Schnoke. Absent were Vice President Mark Brubaker, Mayor Owen Landes, Road Supervisor Dwight Belleman and Road Laborer/Water Technician Benjamin Becker.

There were no Citizens present.

Old Business:

Council reviewed the bids received for the Well No. 9 project, there were four bids received for general construction and two bids received for electrical construction, the bids have been reviewed by the Borough's engineer, Becker Engineering. The low bid for general construction was received from Kinsley Construction LLC, and the low bid received for electrical construction was received from Garden Spot Electric Inc. A motion was made by Matthew Johnson, seconded by James Niethammer to award the Well No. 9 general construction bid to Kinsley Construction LLC in the amount of \$931,500.00 per the recommendation of Becker Engineering; motion unanimously carried. A motion was made by Robert Rittle, seconded by Richard Strickler to award the Well No. 9 electrical construction bid to Garden Spot Electric Inc., in the amount of \$263,900.00 per the recommendation of Becker Engineering; motion unanimously carried.

President Bricker announced that Council will recess the Special Session to enter Executive Session at 7:04 p.m. to discuss personnel matters. The Council returned from Executive Session at 8:43 p.m. reconvening the Special Session after discussing personnel matters with no action taken.

President Bricker asked if there were any comments for the good of the Borough. With no additional matters presented, a motion was made by James Niethammer, seconded by Robert Rittle, to adjourn. Motion unanimously carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:43 p.m.
